PRACTICAL THINGS AMBASSADORS DO

- Identifying families to participate in EB1
- Connect all families to resources (regardless of EB1 participation)
- Provide families of infants with addition support and encouragement such as; participate in the Freezer Fill program, mother or father support groups, connection to home visiting programs
- Help recruit additional Baby Ambassadors Responsible for assisting with implementation of EB1 at your site
- Assist with EB1 Events
- Attend monthly team meeting and required trainings
